

## 2009 Woburn Fund Grants

In 2009, the Woburn Grants Panel reviewed 22 proposals requesting a total of \$162,607. The Panel awarded 9 grants totaling \$32,514. In addition, the Mass Bay District received an award of \$20,000 to support youth, young adult and campus ministry staff and programming.
